October 2021 marks the 100th anniversary of the Herbarium (KW) of the M.G. Kholodny Institute of Botany of NAS of Ukraine, which in 1998 was recognized as the National Heritage Unit, the National Herbarium of Ukraine.

Today, this collection contains more than 2 263 000 storage units and, according to *Index Herbariorum*, ranks the 28th among 3426 herbaria of the world. The history of the National Herbarium of Ukraine is closely connected with the history of the National Academy of Sciences of Ukraine, as the idea of its establishment as an separate unit arose during the formation of the Ukrainian Academy of Sciences in 1918, and was implemented in 1921 by Academician Oleksandr Fomin, the founder and first curator of the newly established collection. Since then, the KW Herbarium has been the main reliable source of information on the diversity of plants and fungi of our country and the many other regions of the world. It serves as the main Ukrainian scientific and information base for fundamental and applied research in botany, mycology, and related fields.

Articles of up to 5 full pages (A4 format) are to be submitted electronically; the file name has to be the first author's name, for example, shevchenko.doc or shevchenko.docx.

The text is prepared in MS Word: Times New Roman; 12 pt.; line spacing – 1.5; no right-edge alignment; all page margins 2 cm; no page numbering. The text may contain one table, up to three photographs or other images (format * .jpg), and not more than 10 references. Components of the text of the publication: title (capital letters, bold); name(s) of the author(s), multiple authors are separeted by commas (*bold italics*); full name of the institution, city, country (*bold*); e-mail of the author(s). Submit your abstract (up to 150 words) and keywords (up to 5 words) after a blank line. Submit the text of the publication with a list of references after a blank line. The format of references and other general requirements for the text are those accepted in the *Ukrainian Botanical Journal* (see https://ukrbotj.co.ua/).
